SUMMARY OF CEMETERY RULES FOR FAMILIES

A. Graves

- 1. Enclosing graves is not permitted.
- 2. Purchasing a plot for future interment is permitted with the plot being placed in the same order as the other graves with the requisite that the necessary brickwork being done within two months of purchase.
- 4. The person with the right to be interred or his/her representative is responsible for the plot.
- 5. Any person opening or closing a grave will be held responsible for any damage caused during the work.
- 6. The Council can not be held responsible for any damage caused by a third party.
- 7. Digging or planting any plants on a grave is forbidden. Placing small stones or creating tiny gardens on any grave is forbidden on lawn cemeteries.
- 8. A newly opened grave, to inter ashes, must be placed in the same order as the other graves.
- 9. It is not permissible to open a grave unless required within three days. (for interment)
- 10. The Community Council is responsible for mowing the grass in a lawn cemetery.

B. Placing Gravestones

- 1. It is necessary for every person working on a monument, either placing or repairing, must be proficient and possess the necessary insurance cover.
- 9. The monuments' owners must keep them in good condition. Owners (if known) will be notified when a monument needs repairing, and if the work is not done within approved time the Council may take measures to make the monument secure.
- 10. The Council will not be held responsible for the damage to any gravestone or monument for any reason.
